Other Registration Requirements in GVS&DD Sani-dump Bylaw No. 346, 2021:

- A. Every owner or operator of a sani-dump that is duly registered must post the proof of registration at a prominent location at the sani-dump.
- B. If any of the information in the existing proof of registration changes, every owner or operator of a sani-dump must provide current information to the District and post a new proof of registration.
- C. Every person must, immediately upon the request of an officer, provide proof of identity and any other information the officer deems necessary to ensure compliance with the GVS&DD Sani-dump Bylaw No. 346, 2021.
